ChristChurch Macy has liturgical worship services because we desire not only to have our worship regulated by the Word of God, but permeated by the Word of God as well. Because of this, we include several responsive readings of Scripture, both an Old Testament and New Testament reading, and a recitation of a traditional creed or confession of the Church. We do not, however, follow a liturgical calendar nor use written prayers. Our typical Order of Service consists of:

- Responsive Call to Worship (Read the Word)
- Prayer of Adoration (Pray the Word)
- Old Testament Scripture Reading (Read the Word)
- Psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs (Sing the Word)
- New Testament Scripture Reading (Read the Word)
- Psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs (Sing the Word)
- Recite Creed/Confession (Confess the Word)
- Responsive Prayer of Thanksgiving & Supplication (Pray the Word)
- Word of Exhortation (Proclaim/Hear the Word)
- Prayer of Confession (Pray the Word)
- Psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs (Sing the Word)
- The Lord's Supper (See the Word)
- Psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs (Sing the Word)
- Benediction (Pray the Word)
- Fellowship (Live the Word)
